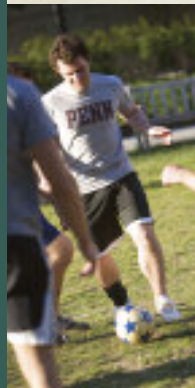
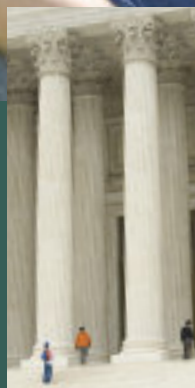

CLINICAL PROGRAMS

A pioneer in clinical legal education, Georgetown Law has developed a top-ranked program that now offers 12 student clinics. Nearly 300 students participate in the clinical program each year, where they gain first-hand insight into the strategic and ethical dimensions of legal practice.

APPELLATE LITIGATION CLINIC

This clinic includes both civil and criminal cases involving federal agencies and exposes students to litigation in at least two federal circuits and the D.C. courts.

CENTER FOR APPLIED LEGAL STUDIES

Students in CALS represent individuals who are seeking political asylum in the United States, but whose requests for asylum have already been rejected by the U.S. government.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE CLINIC

Students in this clinic represent defendants in misdemeanor cases in the D.C. Superior Court, and residents of local detention and correctional centers in post-conviction matters.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CLINIC

Students in the Domestic Violence Clinic represent victims of family abuse in the D.C. Superior Court.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION CLINIC

This clinic is designed to teach students how to become effective legislative lawyers by undertaking projects that advance the public interest.

LAW STUDENTS IN COURT

LSIC is a unique consortium of five law schools whose students provide quality legal representation and counseling to low-income clients in the D.C. area.

The Harrison Institute provides legal services that strengthen political and economic development. The Housing Clinic works in the following areas: multifamily housing, economic opportunity and micro-enterprise and community institution building.

HARRISON INSTITUTE FOR PUBLIC LAW — POLICY CLINIC

The Policy Clinic serves legislators, public officials and nonprofit organizations that actively pursue economic and social reform.

INSTITUTE FOR PUBLIC REPRESENTATION

The Institute works in the areas of communications law, environmental law, civil rights and general public interest matters.

INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S HUMAN RIGHTS CLINIC

The IWHRC program works with United Nations and non-governmental organizations to promote and advance women's human rights throughout the world.

JUVENILE JUSTICE CLINIC

The Juvenile Justice Clinic provides legal representation to adolescents charged with committing misdemeanors or felonies.

STREET LAW

This clinic links law school students with D.C. public high schools, where the law students teach a year-long course in Street Law, and with adult learners, for whom the law students teach a semester-long course in practical law in a community setting.

JOURNALS

Georgetown Law publishes ten student-edited legal journals. Our central mission in publication is to provide timely and relevant scholarly articles, student notes, and comments pertaining to areas of professional legal interest. Eight journals address specific areas of legal concern: Criminal Law, Environmental Law, Immigration Law, International

Law, Legal Ethics, Poverty in America, Gender and the Law and Tax Law. Our newest addition is the Georgetown Journal of Law and Public Policy. The Georgetown Law Journal addresses issues of general legal concern.

MOOT COURT, MOCK TRIAL AND ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION (ADR)

Georgetown Law has a long and rich tradition in appellate and trial advocacy. Georgetown's moot court appellate teams have enjoyed an outstanding national and international reputation, having won first place in many of the most prestigious competitions. Recently, ADR competitions were added to the numerous Georgetown-sponsored regional and national moot court and mock trial competitions. These competitions involve negotiations, mediation and client counseling. The student-run Barristers' Council administers both inter-school and intramural competitions and activities. Students who participate in this program improve their legal research, writing and oral advocacy skills.
